Request

Please treat this as a request under the Freedom of Information Act 2000.
Please provide council-issued on-street parking Penalty Charge Notice data for the top 10 streets/locations by number of parking PCNs issued for the following financial years, shown separately:

1. April 2023 to 31 March 2024
2. April 2024 to 31 March 2025
3. April 2025 to 31 March 2026

For each of the top 10 streets/locations in each financial year, please provide:

1. The street/location name
2. The number of parking PCNs issued
3. The total face value of PCNs issued, before discounts, cancellations or appeal outcomes
4. The contravention reasons for PCNs issued at that street/location, including:
 - contravention code, where held
 - contravention description
 - number of PCNs issued for each contravention reason at that street/location

For clarity, this request is for council-issued or council-enforced on-street parking PCNs only. It excludes off-street council car parks, bus lane PCNs, moving traffic PCNs, Clean Air Zone charges, littering penalties and private parking charges.
